There will be a few differences this time around.

- Schools are deemed to be open. This means that students, have the opportunity to make appointments to receive short one on one instruction from their teachers. Students can contact their teacher to make an appointment, and in other cases, teachers will reach out and schedule an appointment with a student.

Here are the weekly summaries for the courses.
